In this edition, [Tarang Ghahr O Ashti], the artists explore human relationships: Two people sit in opposite directions, yet a shared, flat space between them provides an opportunity to connect. This space can foster dialogue or serve as a point of separation. Ghahr in Persian means "Sulk," while Ashti means "Peace."




# TARANG ['TILTED']

A width of 55 cm is standard for a seating area. With a length of 290 cm and a 5 cm gradient, the bench offers a unique experience. Visually, the gradient is noticeable, but when seated within the 55 cm space, you may be pleasantly surprised by the unexpected comfort. The gentle slope provides a varied seating experience across different parts of the bench, allowing individuals of varying heights to find their ideal spot.
